



**The Australian National University Singapore Alumni Association  
Undergraduate Scholarship**

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**Preamble**

In recognition of the contribution made by its alumni in Singapore to the development of their country and to the reputation of the Australian National University, the University has established the **ANU Singapore Alumni Association Undergraduate Scholarship** to be administered jointly by the ANU Singapore Alumni Association, and the University.

**Title**

The scholarship will be called The Australian National University Singapore Alumni Association Undergraduate Scholarship.

**Award**

The University Awards Committee will award the scholarship annually on the recommendation of The ANU Singapore Alumni Association.

**Eligibility**

The scholarship will be awarded to citizens of Singapore who are normally resident in Singapore, and who have completed their secondary education in, and are immediate school leavers of, Singapore and fulfil the University's minimum admission requirements. Unless required by the University for the purpose of admission, the scholarship will not be awarded to a person who has already undertaken studies at University or equivalent level.

**Criteria**

The Scholarship will be awarded broadly on the basis of academic merit and other appropriate criteria agreed between the Association and the University. These may include, but are not limited to, financial disadvantage or perceived future contribution to the development of Singapore.

**Other Awards**

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis that, during its tenure, the Scholar may hold no other tuition-related scholarship.

**Tenure**

The scholarship will be awarded for the minimum duration of any undergraduate program or combined program (including an Honours year) registered by the University on the Commonwealth Register of Institutions and Programs for Overseas Students (CRICOS)

**Benefits**

The scholarship will meet the full cost of the tuition fees for the minimum duration of any undergraduate program or combined program (including an Honours year) registered by the University on CRICOS. The scholarship includes an annual stipend of AUD10,000.00 payable in two equal amounts of AUD5,000.00 per Semester. No travel, removal or incidental costs are payable under the scholarship.

**Deferment**

The Scholarship may be deferred for a male scholar for a period of up to two years to meet the requirements of Singapore National Service obligations. The scholarship may not be deferred for female scholars.

**Suspension**

During the program and with the approval of the relevant Faculty and the University Awards Committee, the Scholarship may be suspended for a maximum total period of one year in circumstances where Scholars apply to suspend their candidature for the degree for reasons beyond their control.

**Transfer of Program**

A scholar who wishes to transfer to another degree program must obtain the written approval of the relevant Faculty and the University Awards Committee. The scholarship will not be extended beyond the original minimum program duration.

**Termination**

The University Awards Committee may terminate the Scholarship:

1. if in the Committee's opinion the Scholar has failed to make satisfactory academic progress;
2. if the Scholar withdraws, abandons or otherwise terminates their candidature.

**General**

1. Scholars will acknowledge the Singaporean Alumni Association and the University in any reference to this Scholarship.
2. Scholars will make themselves available within reason for any promotional activity related to the Scholarship program including attendance at functions, exhibitions, seminars and school visits.
3. By accepting a Scholarship, Scholars agree to the use of their names and general information on their backgrounds and candidatures for promotional purposes.
4. Scholars will be awarded a Certificate of Recognition.
