
GUIDELINES FOR SJWP 2022 POSTER

Poster Specifications

- 1. The poster should fit one page multiple pages will not be accepted.
- 2. The poster must be in **portrait orientation (vertical**).
- 3. The poster will be A1 size (594mm x 841mm).



Poster Design

- 1. The SJWP banner must be placed at the top of the poster, a PNG version of the banner is attached in the email.
- 2. Below the SJWP banner, the Project Title, Authors and the Name of your School must be included. The information should be clearly displayed and large enough to be visible from a distance at about 1.5 m.
- 3. Title. The Title should be brief (not exceeding two lines) and concise. It should be in bold letters.
- 4. **Authors**. The name(s) of the Author(s) should be spelt out in full. Teacher's name should be included in the Acknowledgements and not as an author. If you received significant assistance from an external advisor, please check with the advisor if they wish to have their names included as an advisor. If not, they can be included in the Acknowledgments.
- 5. For the rest of the content, the following information can be included: (a) Introduction, (b) Methods and Materials, (c) Results and Discussion, (d) Conclusions and Recommendations, (e) Acknowledgements, (f) References. A guide is provided as shown in the template but you are free to design the poster as you deem fit.
- 6. Use of sans serif fonts (eg Arial, Calibri, Tahoma) are encouraged as well as colour tones that provide adequate visual contrast for readability.
- 7. Judges will be using the information in the poster during the interview on your project. Hence, ensure that you provide relevant tables, figures and graphs to support your case. Ensure that the figures, graphs and tables are of high resolution.
- 8. Deadline for the submission of the e-poster (softcopy) is 18 March 2022.
